**\*EXPLANATION OF ZONE DESIGNATIONS**

ZONE	EXPLANATION
A	Areas of 100-year flood; base flood elevations and flood hazard factors not determined.
A0	Areas of 100-year shallow flooding where depths are between one (1) and three (3) feet; average depths of inundation are shown, but no flood hazard factors are determined.
AH	Areas of 100-year shallow flooding where depths are between one (1) and three (3) feet; base flood elevations are shown, but no flood hazard factors are determined.
A1-A30	Areas of 100-year flood; base flood elevations and flood hazard factors determined.
A99	Areas of 100-year flood to be protected by flood protection system under construction; base flood elevations and flood hazard factors not determined.
B	Areas between limits of the 100-year flood and 500-year flood; or certain areas subject to 100-year flooding with average depths less than one (1) foot or where the contributing drainage area is less than one square mile; or areas protected by levees from the base flood. (Medium shading)
C	Areas of minimal flooding. (No shading)
D	Areas of undetermined, but possible, flood hazards.
V	Areas of 100-year coastal flood with velocity (wave action); base flood elevations and flood hazard factors not determined.
V1-V30	Areas of 100-year coastal flood with velocity (wave action); base flood elevations and flood hazard factors determined.

Certain areas not in the special flood hazard areas (zones A and V) may be protected by flood control structures.

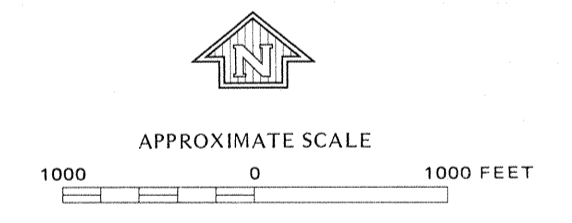

RM23	639.83	City of Superior brass cap set in a protective case in the northeast corner of the intersection of E and 2nd Street and 48th Avenue East 24.0 feet east of the centerline of 2nd Street and 30.0 feet north of the centerline of 48th Avenue East, stamped "3393-79"
RM24	665.02	Spike in east side of third powerpole in a group of four from the east, 81.0 feet south of the last set of tracks in the Burlington Northern ore yards, 2000.0 feet southeast of the white two-story control house. (Owen Ayres and Association)
RM27	615.30	Chiseled square; upstream left wingwall of steel truss bridge on County Trunk Highway "A" over Nemadji River, 14.0 feet from centerline of road and level with road. (Owen Ayres and Association)
RM28	635.05	Chiseled yellow square on upstream right corner of box culvert over Bear Creek under City Limits Road, 18.0 feet south of the centerline of road, 10.0 feet below the road surface. (Owen Ayres and Association)
RM30	647.68	U.S. Coast and Geodetic Survey brass cap, southeast corner of intersection of the Burlington Northern Railway and Moccasin Mike Road, 48.0 feet south centerline of road, and 39.0 feet east of railroad centerline, on top of square concrete post stamped "H-44-1934"
