The undersigned, whether one or more, for and in consideration of the sum of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00), cash in hand paid, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, and in further consideration of that certain RIGHT OF WAY GRANT dated August 21, 1953, and recorded in the Office of Register of Deeds for Douglas County, Wisconsin in Book 236 of Deeds at Page 235-238; or as Document Number 416375; and Right of Way Grant dated October 7, 1953, and recorded in Book 237 of Deeds at Page 377; or as Document Number 417495; and Right of Way Grant dated September 18, 1953, and recorded in Book 236 of Deeds at Page 590; or as Document Number 416896; whereunder LAKEHEAD PIPE LINE COMPANY, INC., a Delaware Corporation of 119 North 25th Street East, P. O. Box 789, Superior, Wisconsin 54880, was granted a right of way and easement to lay, operate and maintain a pipeline (with the right to install additional pipelines) for the transportation of crude petroleum, its products and derivatives, together with the necessary fixtures, equipment and appurtenances, over, through, upon, under and across the following described land situated in Douglas County, State of Wisconsin, to-wit:

Lots 291, 293, 295, 297, 299 and 301, Block 33 on East 16th Street and Lots 290, 292, 294, 296 and 298, Block 34 on East 17th Street all in Industrial Center, being a subdivision of blocks in the Eastern Division of the Townsite of Superior, in the City of Superior.

does hereby authorize the said Lakehead Pipe Line Company, Inc., its successors and assigns, to install, operate and maintain on the lands above described pursuant to the said RIGHT OF WAY GRANT a valve and auxiliary facilities including a cubicle for housing valve controls and protective fencing around an area of approximately 30' x 30'.

Lakehead Pipe Line Company, Inc. shall have the right of ingress and egress to and from said valve and auxiliary facilities for the purpose of construction, maintenance and repair.

The undersigned further acknowledges and agrees that the consideration so received shall constitute not only consideration for this authorization, but shall also constitute payment in full for all damages, of whatsoever nature and kind which might arise by reason of the installation and construction of said valve and auxiliary facilities.

This instrument shall be binding upon the heirs, executors, administrators, successors and assigns of the parties hereto.
