RM3	1146.97	Railroad spike in north side of 19-inch white pine tree, 22.0 feet south and 65.0 feet west of the T-intersection of County Trunk Highway B (Cherry Street) and a private drive, 0.3 foot above ground, 0.16 mile west of Mattson Road. (Owen Ayres & Associates)
RM4	1105.27	Chiseled square on downstream left wingwall of the County Trunk Highway B (Cherry Street) bridge over Nebagamon Creek, 30.0 feet from and 1.6 feet below centerline of road, on north end of wall. (Owen Ayres & Associates)
RM12	1105.70	Chiseled square on upstream left abutment of Mattson Road bridge over Nebagamon Creek, 1250 feet south of County Trunk Highway B (Cherry Street), 12.0 feet from and 0.2 foot below centerline of road. (Owen Ayres & Associates)

***EXPLANATION OF ZONE DESIGNATIONS**

ZONE	EXPLANATION
A	Areas of 100-year flood; base flood elevations and flood hazard factors not determined.
A0	Areas of 100-year shallow flooding where depths are between one (1) and three (3) feet; average depths of inundation are shown, but no flood hazard factors are determined.
AH	Areas of 100-year shallow flooding where depths are between one (1) and three (3) feet; base flood elevations are shown, but no flood hazard factors are determined.
A1-A30	Areas of 100-year flood; base flood elevations and flood hazard factors determined.
A99	Areas of 100-year flood to be protected by flood protection system under construction; base flood elevations and flood hazard factors not determined.
B	Areas between limits of the 100-year flood and 500-year flood; or certain areas subject to 100-year flooding with average depths less than one (1) foot or where the contributing drainage area is less than one square mile; or areas protected by levees from the base flood. (Medium shading)
C	Areas of minimal flooding. (No shading)
D	Areas of undetermined, but possible, flood hazards.
V	Areas of 100-year coastal flood with velocity (wave action); base flood elevations and flood hazard factors not determined.
V1-V30	Areas of 100-year coastal flood with velocity (wave action); base flood elevations and flood hazard factors determined.

This map is for flood insurance purposes only; it does not necessarily show all areas subject to flooding in the community or all planimetric features outside special flood hazard areas.

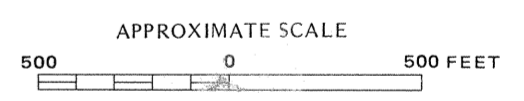
