

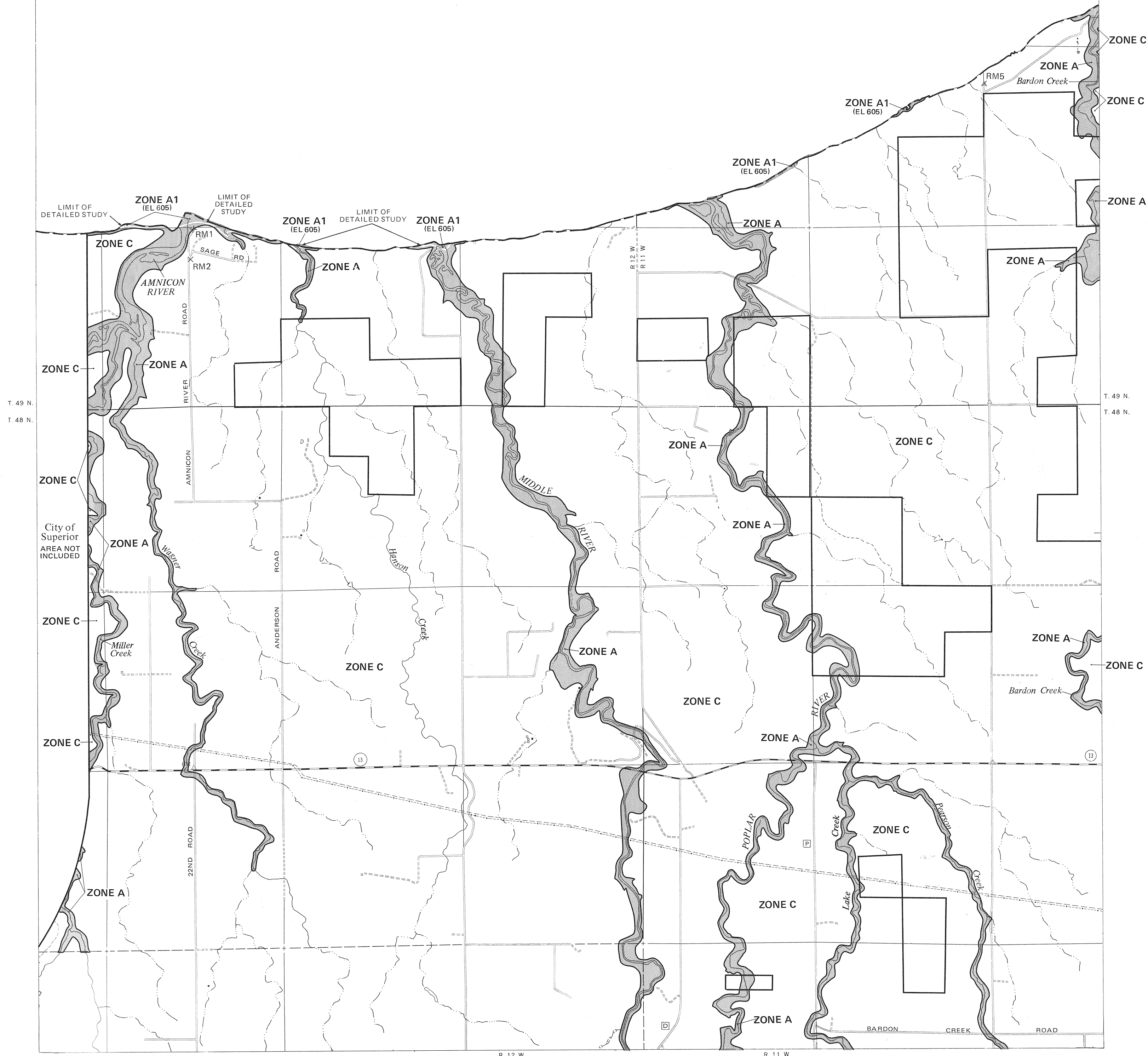

REFERENCE MARK	ELEVATION (FT. NGVD)	DESCRIPTION OF LOCATION
RM1	605.58	Spike in east side of power pole no. 2.91, 29.0 feet northwest of Amnicon River Road, 75.0 feet south of a T-intersection east with private drive, fire number "LK 301", 1.0 foot above ground, near boat landing, 4.0 miles east of Superior, Wisconsin, in the north-east quarter of Section 34, T49N, R12W.
RM2	658.52	U.S. Geological Survey triangulation station, 38.0 feet east of the T-intersection of Amnicon River Road and Sage Road, 27.0 feet northeast of a power pole, and set in top of concrete post stamped "Amin, 1952", 2.8 miles north of State Trunk Highway "13", 4.0 miles east of Superior, Wisconsin, in the northeast quarter of Section 34, T49N, R12W.
RM3*	663.88	U.S. Geological Survey marker, 120.0 feet east and 26.0 feet north of the T-intersection south of Woods Road and Moccasin Mike Road, 45.0 feet west of a private drive, stamped "TT 13L 1943", 2.3 miles north of State Trunk Highway "13", and 0.5 mile east of Superior, Wisconsin, in the southeast quarter of Section 31, T49N, R12W.
RM5	677.40	U.S. Geological Survey marker, 226.0 feet north of 26.0 feet east of the T-intersection of Peterson Road and De Vries Road, 30.0 feet south of the top of bank overlooking Lake Superior, set in top of concrete post stamped "TT 55L 1943 RESET 1952", 8.0 miles east of the corporate limits of Superior, Wisconsin, in the north quarter of Section 28, T49N, R11W.

\*EXPLANATION OF ZONE DESIGNATIONS

ZONE	EXPLANATION
A	Areas of 100-year flood; base flood elevations and flood hazard factors not determined.
A0	Areas of 100-year shallow flooding where depths are between one (1) and three (3) feet; average depths of inundation are shown, but no flood hazard factors are determined.
AH	Areas of 100-year shallow flooding where depths are between one (1) and three (3) feet; base flood elevations are shown, but no flood hazard factors are determined.
A1-A30	Areas of 100-year flood; base flood elevations and flood hazard factors determined.
A99	Areas of 100-year flood to be protected by flood protection system under construction; base flood elevations and flood hazard factors not determined.
B	Areas between limits of the 100-year flood and 500-year flood; or certain areas subject to 100-year flooding with average depths less than one (1) foot or where the contributing drainage area is less than one square mile; or areas protected by levees from the base flood. (Medium shading)
C	Areas of minimal flooding. (No shading)
D	Areas of undetermined, but possible, flood hazards.
V	Areas of 100-year coastal flood with velocity (wave action); base flood elevations and flood hazard factors not determined.
V1-V30	Areas of 100-year coastal flood with velocity (wave action); base flood elevations and flood hazard factors determined.

Certain areas not in the special flood hazard areas (zones A and V) may be protected by flood control structures.  
This map is for flood insurance purposes only; it does not necessarily show all areas subject to flooding in the community or all planimetric features outside special flood hazard areas.

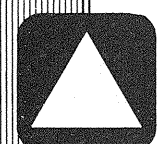
